Installation Instructions

1. Extract the **PromoRuleMatrix extension package** into a folder with a decompression utility such as **7-Zip**.
2. The following folder will be extracted into your specified folder:
 - ArtsOnIT_Buy1Free-0.1.0
3. Open the **ArtsOnIT_Buy1Free-0.1.0** folder and you will find the following subfolders:
 - app/code/community/ArtsOnIT
 - app/etc/modules
 - app/locale
 - app/design
 - ioncube
4. Upload the **ioncube** folder into the root your website and point your web browser to:
<http://www.mystore.com/ioncube/loader-wizard.php>

(Replace **mystore.com** with the actual domain name of your website)

5. Follow the instructions provided by the online guide until the **ioncube** loader is successfully installed.
6. If you have installed Magento into the root folder of your website, please upload the remaining files and folders to the corresponding folders in the root folder of your website.

If you have installed Magento into a specific folder on your website, please upload the remaining files and folders to the corresponding folders in that specific folder on your website.
7. If you use a non-English locale for your store, copy the **ArtsOnIT_Buy1Free.csv** file from **app/locale/en_US** folder into the locale language folder that you use, such as the following for Portuguese (Brazil):
 - app/locale/pt_BR
8. Open the **ArtsOnIT_Buy1Free.csv** file to edit the 2nd column for language translation (if required), save the file and upload it to the corresponding locale folder on your website.

Installation is complete now. Please proceed to the **Configuration Instructions** in the next section to configure the extension settings before use.

Configuration Instructions

1. Log in to the **Admin Panel** of your online store with your username and password.
2. If you have turned on the Magento cache for your online store, go to **System > Cache Management** and refresh all the caches. Otherwise, skip to the next step.
3. **Log out** from the **Admin Panel** of your online store and **log in again**.
4. Go to **Promotions > Shopping Cart Price Rules** section.
5. Add a new rule by clicking on the **Add New Rule** button.
6. Set the **Rule Name** and other information for the new rule.
In the following example, we will be setting a new rule for **Buy 3, Get 1 Free** for Markers.

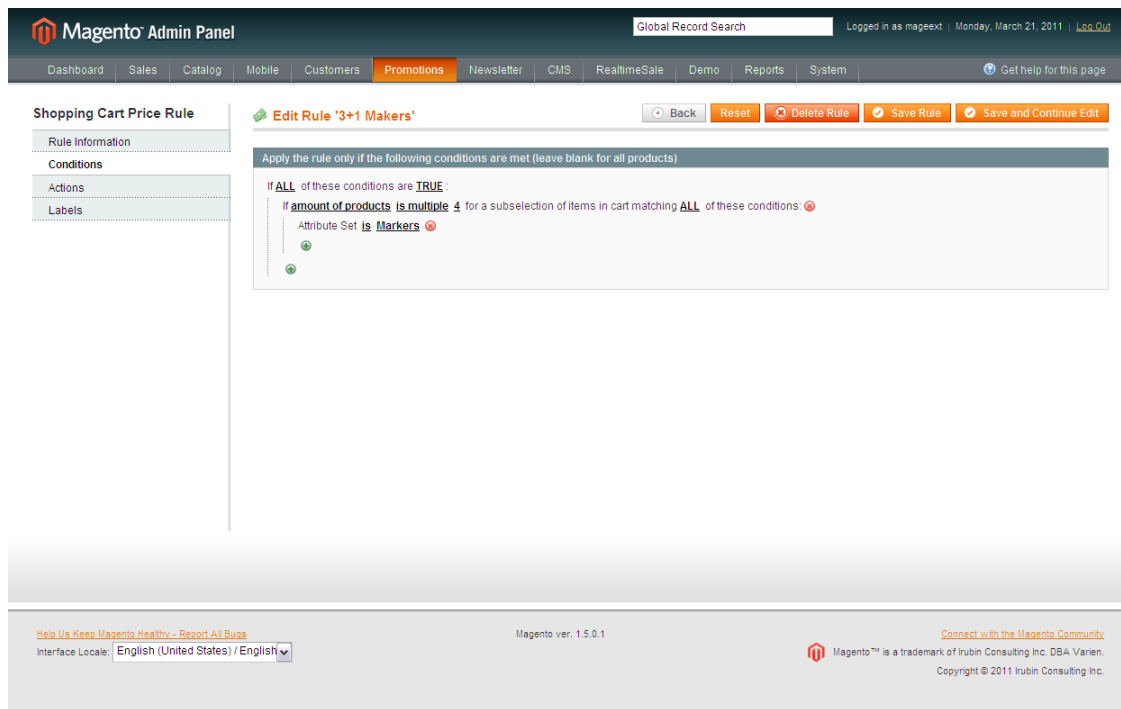
7. Click on the **Conditions** tab on the left and add a new condition called **Min amount of products**.

8. Set the **Conditions** to the following example:

If **ALL** of these conditions are **TRUE**:

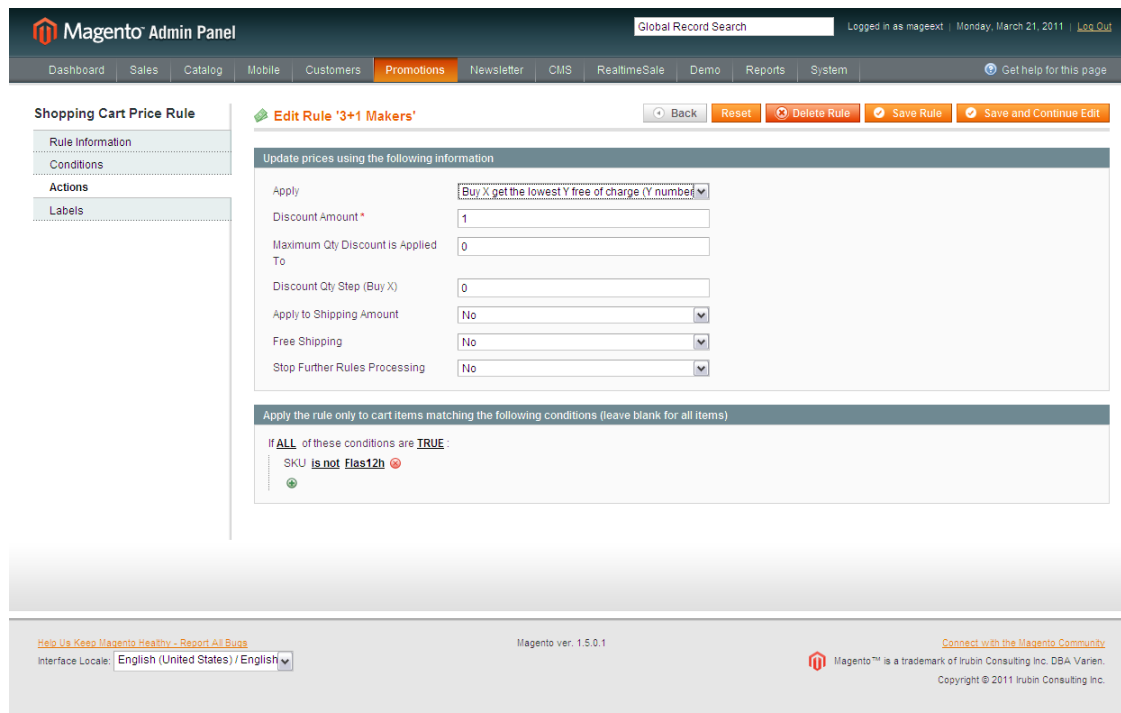
If **amount of product is multiple 4** for a subselection of items in cart matching **ALL** of these conditions:

Attribute Set **is Markers**



(Replace **Markers** with your preferred **attribute set** in your store)

- Go to the **Actions** tab and set it according to the following and replace the SKU shown on the screenshot with any product SKU you wish to exclude for this promo rule:



- Set the **Label** for the rule to be displayed in the store view(s):

11. Click **Save Rule** button near the top right to save the new rule. You may use different conditional statements, actions and settings to make your own promo rule.
